The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Hopkins, who moved its adoption; said motion being seconded by Commissicner Gray. Chairman ordered the Resolution read.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it appears that on January 11th, 1934, Claude J. Perry and Martha Perry, husband and wife of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, deeded to the State of Oklahoma the following described property to-wit:

"Beginning at a point 50 feet West of the N.E. corner of Block 2 Perry's sub-division of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 31, Township 19 N, Range 13 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, thence South a distance of 500 feet, thence West on a line parallel to the North line of said Block 2 a distance of 620 feet thence North a distance of 500 feet, thence east on the North line of said Block 2, 620 feet to point of beginning. Containing seven and eleven hundredths (7.11) acres more or less according to recorded plat thereof."

AND WHEREAS, the County Engineer of Tulsa County has this day reported to the County Commissioners of Tulsa County that said lake to be erected upon the above described property has not been completed.

AND WHEREAS, the County engineer of Tulsa County has failed to ask additional funds from the Excise Board to complete the lake.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County that the above project has no intrinsic value to the citizenship of Tulsa County and deems it to the best interest of Tulsa County not to request or make any appropriation to complete said lake and asks the Governor of the State of Oklahoma to deed said property back to its original owner.
