

Your petitioner further agrees that the poles shall not be set nearer the center of the section line than 21½ feet and that any time in the future shall such poles, or the accessories, interfere with the construction of improvement of said road, your petitioner agrees upon order from the county to immediately remove the same without expense to the county to such locations as may be required by the county so as not to interfere with the construction and maintenance of the road.

Your petitioner further agrees that it will obey all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the state of Oklahoma in the construction and maintenance of said lines.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that it may be granted permission to construct said line along the highways, as above set out.

BUILDER'S CONTRACT. (With Bond)

This Agreement made this 7th day of December, 1920, between, I. J. Buck, Contractor, party of the first part, and Board of Commissioners, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, owners, parties of the second part;

WITNESSETH; That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the payments to be made to him by the said second parties, hereinafter provided does hereby covenant, contract and agree to erect and complete one building on County Farm (about nine miles Southeast of City of Tulsa.) Same to be built in accordance with alternate specified, calling for brick faced walls, backed with hollow clay tile, basement walls and foundations walls where below grade line to be built of rubble stone work as specified, otherwise the entire building to be constructed according to the plans, specifications and drawings (which are declared a part of this agreement), made by M. C. Cross, architect, (acting as agent for said owner in a good and substantial and workmanlike manner, to the satisfaction of and under the direction of the architect.

And said first party, also does agree to find, provide and furnish all labor and materials of such kinds, qualities and descriptions as shall be fit, proper and sufficient for completing and finishing all the work or works mentioned (provided that possession of the premises be given the contractor on or before June 1st, 1921. Time to be extended only in case of general strike, alternations, fire or unusual action of the elements.

And the second parties for and in consideration of the first party completely and faithfully executing the aforesaid work, and furnishing all the materials therefore, so as fully to carry out this contract, and the design, according to its true spirit, meaning and
