Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and temporarily unanimously carried, that the appointment of Hazel Wilson as Deputy in the County Assessor's office, at a salary of \$200.00 per month, effective June 1, 1950, be and the same is hereby approved. Miss Wilson is replacing Marie Gers, who resigned.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the following Resolution be, and the same is hereby adopted.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Independent District No. 1, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and the Board of Education of Independent District No. 2, of Sand Springs, Oklahoma, have each requested that the Board of County Commissioners transfer to said respective school districts, such separate school bond funds as to which they may be respectively entitled, for use by them in the permanent improvement of the separate schools of Tulsa County in their respective districts, as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, there appears to be \$155,000.00, balance of unincumbered funds of the county separate school improvement bond issue of 1948, which may be so transferred as provided by Section 13, Article 15 of House Bill 120 of the 1949 Legislature (1949 Session Laws page 570); and

WHEREAS, the sum of \$35,000.00 thereof was heretofore designated by the Board for the use of the separate schools of the Sand Springs Independent School District, and it has at all times been contemplated that any balance of funds, after the building and equipping of Booker T. Washington High School, of the Tulsa City School District, should be allocated for the use of the separate schools of the Tulsa City Independent School District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Clerk and County Treasurer be, and they each are, hereby authorized, empowered and directed, in manner provided by law, to transfer and deliver to the Treasurer of Independent District No. 2, of Sand Springs, Oklahoma, proceeds of the 1948 bond separate school improvement bonds to the amount of \$35,000.00, as required by said Section 13, of Article 15 of House Bill 120 of the 1949 Legislature, and to transfer and deliver to the Treasurer of Independent School District No. 1 of Tulsa, Oklahoma, proceeds of said 1948 separate school improvement bonds to the amount of \$120,000.00, as provided by said House Bill 120;
