TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA:

The undersigned hereby request permission and authorization from your Board to construct certain water lines in public roads or highways outside of corporate cities or towns in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as shown in the plat which is hereto attached and made a part of this application; the location of the proposed water lines being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A 4-inch Cast Iron Water Line on 33rd Street, from Lewis Avenue, East approximately 815 feet, and approximately 165 feet on Lewis Avenue, South of 33rd Street.

It is understood and agreed that said permission and authorization, if granted, shall be subject to the following provisions which are hereby agreed to by applicant:

- 1. Permanent markers shall be placed by the applicant showing the location of said water lines.
- 2. The applicant agrees to maintain and keep in good repair the said water lines until such time as the land on which they are located is annexed to the City of Tulsa.
- 3. The applicant hereby relieves the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, of and from any liability for injury to said water lines in connection with work on the roads performed by or under the authority of said Board of County Commissioners.
- 4. Applicant agrees that the said water lines shall not interfere with the use or maintenance of the public roads.
