THEREFORE, We the members of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, do hereby proclaim the afternoon of Friday, September 20th, a half holiday, and decree that the Court House be closed at noon of said day in order that county employees may attend the Fair and it is hereby requested and urged that oil companies and other business institutions take similar action in releasing their employees for the afternoon for the purpose of participating in this outstanding patriotic occasion.
