# R E S O L U T I O N.

Whereas, the Big Four Paving Company, having under contract and not built, Contracts number twenty four (24) and Twenty Five (25), for the construction of concrete roads in Tulsa County, more fully described as follows: "Contract No. 24: All of mile three and approximately 4,500 lineal feet of Mile 2, of Section "L"; and Contract No. 25, All of miles four and five of Section "L"; and

Whereas, the said Big Four Paving Company has submitted to the Board of County Commissioners an agreement assigning to Max L. Cunningham all their right and title in said contracts and asking that such assignment be approved and the Big Four Paving Company be released for responsibility for the construction of the work contemplated and from their bonds guaranteeing completion of same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, That such assignment of contract by the Big Four Paving Company to Max L. Cunningham and the release of the said bonds be approved, provided that such action is approved by the County Judge of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
