

In the matter of the application of the GULF PIPE LINE COMPANY for permission to lay and maintain three telephone and telegraph wires on the Bridge over Arkansas River at or near Jenks, the following order was made:

NOW, on this 25th. day of August, 1930, the Board of County Commissioners being met in regular session, the application of the Gulf Pipe Line Company of Pennsylvania for the right, privilege and authority to lay and amaintain three telephone and telegraph wires over, and along and across the County bridge belonging to said County and extending over the Arkansas River at a point near Jenks in said County, wires to be strung on cross beams attached to the superstructure of such bridge in such manner as not to impede or endganger public travel or traffic along said bridge, comes on to be heard.

After considering the same, the Board is of the opinion that said application should be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND CONSIDERED that permission be and the same is hereby granted to the Gulf Pipe Line Company of Pennsylvania to lay and maintain the three telephone and telegraph wires names in its application at the place and in the manner named in said application for a term of Fifteen (15) Years, beginning the 25th. day of August, 1930, for an annual rental of Six (\$6.00) Dollars to be paid in advance by said Gulf Pipe Line Company of Pennsylvania to Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
