

PROPOSAL FOR CONSTRUCTION OF 20 FOOT SPAN
24 FOOT ROADWAY BRIDGE BETWEEN SECS. 4 & 9,
T.17, R.14 AT WILLOW SPRINGS SCHOOL HOUSE.

"Hon. County Commissioners,
Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Gentlemen:

The undersigned, having examined the plans, the location and character of the work, the class of materials to be used, etc., in connection with the construction of a bridge over Willow Springs Branch, near the Willow Springs School House, between Sections 4 and 9, Township 17 North, Range 14 East, submits the following proposal:

NOTE: All exposed concrete to be rubbed down and dressed with carborundum brick to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

We agree to begin the work within 15 days from this date and to complete the entire structure in a satisfactory manner, strictly in accord with the State Standard Specifications, and in accordance with the instructions of the County Engineer within 45 days from this date, and upon failure to do so, the County may deduct from final settlement the sum of \$10.00 per day for each day thereafter the work remains uncompleted. It is further agreed that this proposal may be extended to cover other work of a similar nature in adjacent territory, and at the same prices as are herein bid.

Certified check (Bidders Bond) amounting to approximately 10% of the amount of this proposal is hereto attached.
