

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 11, 1990 CONTINUED

Motion by Harris, seconded by Selph, to approve the use of space in the Courthouse basement, as submitted in Edwards' memo of October 3, 1990, including the recommendation that the Public Defender assume the space to be vacated by the Pre-Trial Release/Misdemeanant Program. Upon roll call, Harris, yes; Selph, yes; Rice, yes. Motion carried.

Rice directed Edwards to continue monitoring the project, and, as funding becomes available, to coordinate all renovation and remodeling with the Board and the County Engineer.

Selph explained a recommendation to obtain the services of The Executive Service Corps of Tulsa (TESCOT), operating through the Metropolitan Tulsa Chamber of Commerce, for the purpose of reviewing the services provided by the Building Operations and Inspections Divisions. Selph noted that, with both the divisions' directors retiring, it is an appropriate time to do this. Selph further explained that the only costs involved with this would be reimbursement for actual expenses, such as photocopies, etc. A contract defining the scope of services to be provided and the cost to the board would be presented for formal approval.

Motion by Selph, seconded by Harris, to approve the recommendation to contract with TESCOT for their services. Upon roll call, Harris, yes; Selph, yes; Rice, yes. Motion carried.

Harris asked that the record reflect this was in no way to be considered criticism of these divisions or the directors who are retiring, simply a matter of reviewing the functions provided by these departments.


Edwards is to coordinate this project and the Chairman will draft a memo to him, including Harris' comments with copies to Helton and Hallock.
