#### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County has spent a vast amount of money and unlimited time and effort to build up an unexcelled system of highways in Tulsa County, and

WHEREAS, there have been called to our attention numerous cases where great damage has been done to bridges, pavement and oiled roads by reason of moving heavy and destructive objects over the roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the practice of moving buildings, farm tractors, oil field equipment, etc. of a destructive nature over any Tulsa County or Township road be abolished, unless sufficient Bond is given to the County to cover any damage.

On account of the condition of the times, and from the fact that information has reached me to the effect that there will be only one County Investigator in this County whereas there has heretofore always been two Investigators, and it will necessarily require more time to be devoted to criminal investigation by the Sheriff's Office in the future than in the past, and my experience has been from actual observation that with the present force of deputies it will be impossible for me to give to the citizens of this County the best administration from a point of law enforcement without additional Deputies; I, therefore, request this Honorable Body to permit me to appoint by and with their consent three (3) additional regular Deputy Sheriffs, their salaries to be paid as other deputies.

I herewith submit the following names for the proposed appointments: T J Duckett, W D Foor and Wallace Davis.
