
Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M., July 7th with the following members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman, Curtis Greer, Member, Andy Stokes, County Clerk. Robert L. Kinkaid, Member, absent.

J. B. Gray, Chairman, presiding, the following business was transacted.

After an examination of the Request of each of the County Officers and Boards of Tulsa County, motion was made by Commissioner Greer, and seconded by Commissioner Gray, that all of said Requests be approved and ordered entered into the 1944-1945 Estimate of Needs and filed with the County Clerk on or before July 10th; and it is further ordered that said statement contain a Financial Statement of the condition of all funds for Tulsa County as of June 30, 1944. The requests as approved are in the total sum of \$1,066,923.75. It is further moved, after the filing as provided by Law, that said statement be advertised as provided by Statute. Upon roll call both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried;

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray that the request as made by the County Superintendent to this Board for the Dependent Separate Schools of Tulsa County for the Fiscal Year 1944-1945 in the amount of \$26,670.00 be approved, and that said Estimate, together with Financial Statement, of said Separate Schools be filed with the County Clerk on or before July 10th, and that publication be made as provided by Statute. Upon roll call both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that a recess be taken until Thursday, July 13th, at the hour of 10:00 A. M. Motion carried.
