

THURSDAY, JULY 13, 1944

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M. Thursday, July 13th, with the following members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman, Robert L. Kinkaid, Member, Andy Stokes, County Clerk. Curtis Greer, Member, absent. J.B.Gray, Chairman presiding, following business was transacted. Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, to recess until 11:00 A.M. Motion carried.

AFTER RECESS 11:00 o'clock A.M.
Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 11:00 o'clock A.M. with all members present and presiding as before.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$30,266.27, be and the same is hereby approved and ordered submitted to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Restricted Cash Fund in the amount of \$11,534.65, be and the same is hereby approved and ordered submitted to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that because of the protest filed by the Tulsa-Sapulpa Union Railway Company to the letting of a contract for the construction of a timber trestle at a crossing on the Tulsa-Sapulpa Union Railway Company, and the now Cherry Creek Channel of Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12, the opening of the bids be postponed until the next regular Meeting date of July 17th. Mr. Stebbins one of the Bidders being present made no objection to the continuance agreement that the bids be opened at the next regular meeting. Upon roll call both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, Seconded by Commissioner Gray, that upon the recommendation of Joe T. Parkinson, County Treasurer, the following orders be approved. Upon roll call, both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
