#### R E S O L U T I O N .

WHEREAS, it appears that the taxes against most of the property in Morningside addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma have never been paid for the years 1909, 1910, 1911 and 1912, and

WHEREAS, it appears from the records that several plats have been filed affecting said addition in which the meets and bounds, and sizes of the lots in said addition have been considerably changed from the original plat thereof, and

Whereas, many of the present owners of ~~xxxx~~ property in said addition desire to pay the taxes for said years, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, at various times in the past have made an order striking the taxes for said years against said property, under the impression and belief that said property was non-taxable by reason of being located upon the homestead of a creek Indian, and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of the United States has held that all such lands are taxable.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma that the county assessor be and he is hereby ordered and directed to re-assess said above described property for the said years of 1909, 1910, 1911 and 1912, dividing the same, extending the proportionate part of the taxes against said property, as nearly as may be, according to the present ownership of said property, in order that the owners thereof may pay all such taxes.

#### S E A L

Upon application of W. B. Williams, County Judge of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to increase the salary of the reporter within and for said county court in the amount of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, a motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by Ed Dalton that the stenographer in the county Court be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$150.00 per month for salary. All members voting in favor of the motion the same was by the Chairman declared carried.

A motion was made by Ed Dalton and seconded by F. M. Wooden that C. P. Alexander be allowed a decrease in valuation of \$11300.00 on account of the improvements on the north 43 feet of lot six (6) and the south 26.3 feet of lot seven in block One Hundred Five being practically destroyed by fire, leaving remaining thereof, one certain brick ~~wall~~ wall, and that the said C. P. Alexander be required to pay on a valuation of \$5000.00. Motion carried.
