

MONDAY, JULY 17, 1944

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 A. M., with the following members present: J. G. Gray, Chairman, Curtis Greer and Robert L. Kinkaid, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Mr. Earl Foster, representing the Tulsa-Sapulpa Union Railway Company, presented an objection by that Company to the letting of a contract for a timber trestle at a crossing on the Tulsa-Sapulpa Union Railway Company's track and the now Cherry Creek Channel of the Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12. Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the objection be overruled. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

The following sealed bids on the construction of a timber trestle over the Tulsa-Sapulpa Union Railway Company's track and the now Cherry Creek Channel of the Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12 were opened:

Stebbins Construction Company's bid of \$8,740.00, together with a Cashier's Check for \$450.00 as security, and Ottinger Brothers bid for \$8,800.00, together with a certified check for \$440.00 as security. Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that these bids be referred to the Engineers for their recommendation. Upon roll call all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by Emile F. Sterger, Clerk of the Common Pleas Court, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Gray that the following claims on Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12, be and the same are hereby approved:
