SPECIAL MEETING.

The Board of County Commissioners met in special session called by the County Clerk in their Rooms at 8:00 P.M. All members present.

A general discussion was had relative to the various funds of the County.

The claim of J. M. McGowan for \$377.28 on the Road & Bridge fund was allowed.

Upon motion, an agreement was entered into with the M. K. & T. R.R., as per Resolution and Agreement on file in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, relative to the following lands for right of way for a road in Wekiwa Township:

"A strip of ground situated in sections 4, 5 and 9, Township 19 North, Range 11 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as follows:

A strip of ground fifty feet wide the northerly line of which is the North line of right of way of the MK&T Ry., and the southerly line of which is parallel with and fifty feet northerly from the center line of said railway; said strip beginning at a point about 1728 feet easterly from the West line of said Section 5, measured along said center line at Mile Post 267.37 and extending easterly 7800 feet to a point about 1968 feet westerly measured along said center line from the East line of said Section 9, above named point being at Mile Post 268.91".
