B.Day, County Judge Pro-Tem, be approved. Upon roll call all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the appointment of Daisy Garrison, Special Night Matron, to serve fifteen days during the absence of Mrs. J.B.Demet at a salary of \$125.00, as made by A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff, be approved. Upon roll call all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the appointment of <u>F. C.Welch</u>, as Deputy Assessor, replacing Homer King who resigned, at a salary of \$200.00 per month, as made by Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, be approved. Upon roll call all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman, declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that upon the recommendation of the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas, the salary of E. M. Lotridge be increased to \$175.00 per month effective as of July 1, 1944. Upon roll call all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that a recess be taken until the hour of 2:00 0'clock P. M. Motion carried.
