The polls shall be opened at eight o'clock A. M. and remain open continuously until and be closed at six o'clock P. M. excepting in cities of the first class and in all precincts surrounding, bounding or adjoining said cities of the first class where the polls shall be opened at six o'clock A. M. and shall remain open continuously until and be closed at seven o'clock P. M.

All registered, qualified electors of the county will be permitted to vote upon the above question.

A RESOLUTION REPEALING AND REVOKING A CERTAIN RESOLUTION PASSED BY THIS BOARD ON THE 21 DAY OF OCTOBER 1946 ENTITIED "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CALLING OF AN ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING UPON THE QUISTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE NEGOTIABLE COUPON BONDS OF TUISA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, FOR THE PRUPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A BRIDGE."

WHEREAS this Board of County Commissioners on the 21st day of October, 1946 passed a resolution authorizing and directing the Chairman of said Board to call an election in said county to be held on the 26th day of November, 1946 on the question of the issuance of the bonds of said county for the purpose of constructing a bridge across the Arkansas River of Jenks in Sections 19 and 20, Township 18 North, Range 13 East; and
