Motion carried.

Motion was made by Mr.Hedgecock, seconded by Mr.North, that Julia Ellis, General Delivery, Tulsa, and W W Palmer, General Delivery, Bixby, be and they are hereby granted an allowance of \$10.00 per month, until further notice. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Mr.Hedgecock, seconded by Mr.D ckey, that claims numbered 165292, 166064 and 166066 be and the same are hereby disallowed. Carried.

In the matter of the petition of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, the foldowing Order was made:

ORDE.R

NOW, On this the 15th. day of Sept. 1930, the matter of the Petition of the Southwestern Bell Telephone Company for permission to place a Manhole and four underground Laterals along certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County C mmissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Cômmissioners thereof that it was just that the said Southwestern Bell Telephone Company be permitted to cut paving if necessary in placing four underground laterals as designted by description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Proposed reinforced concrete manhole to be placed in the dirst triangle formed by the intersection of Harvard and 51st. Streets and located in the southwest corner of Section 28, Range 13, Township 20 North, Tulsa county, said manhole to be 5'6" deep, 6' long, 4' wide.

From this manhole four conduit laterals to be extended, as follows:
One North, one East, One West and One South. A 3" galvanized iron
pipe to be pushed under the pavement approximately 75' north to a
pole located 21' west of the center line of the pavement. To the
East the pipe will be pushed 50' south under pavement. From this
point, 175' of Creo Wood Duct will be placed east to a light pole,
which is 24' south of the center lines of pavement. To the south a
3" galvanized iron pipe will be pushed 50' south under pavement. From
this point, 173' of Creo Wood Duct will be placed to a pole 23' East of
center line of pavement. To the west a 3" galvanized iron pipe will
pushed 84' under pavement, and from this point 31' of Creo Wood Duct
will be placed to a light pole located 22' north of center line of
pavement.

All the above conduit laterals will be laid 24" under surface.

AND, it further appearing from the Petition herein that said manhole and laterals will be so constructed as not to interfere wit any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County C_{o} mmissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED BY the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.
