Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey that the Quarterly Report of Water Improvement District No. 3 be and the same is hereby approved, as of March 15, 1950 to June 15, 1950.

Motion made by Commissioner Hardesty, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried that the Resale Tax Deed on - Lot 7, Block 16, O. T. Sand Springs, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, at tax resale of 1938 for delinquent taxes for years 1932 to 1937 inclusive, be approved.

Denton as Sixth Assistant County Attorney at a salary of \$4,500.00 per year, effective June 1, 1950 be approved and also that Harold M. Shultz, Jr. be raised to \$4,500.00 per year be approved.
