Wheras, pursuant to a request of N. J. Gubser, former County Judge of to request Tulsa County, Oklahoma, his books from July 1st, 1910, to Jan. 6th, 1913, were of N. J. Gub examined by the State Examiner and Inspector upon a resolution of this Board, ser and whereas said report has been filed with this Board and whereas it appears from said report that said State Examiner contends that for the period of April 15th, 1910, to Jan. 9th, 1911, said Gubser was overpaid in salary the sum of \$366.03 by this County, and whereas said report shows that the said Gubser agreed that said question as to the legality of said payment of \$366.03 be submitted upon stipulation to a court of proper jurisdiction, and whereas said question has not been passed upon by the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, and whereas said Gubser and the Board of County Commissioners are willing that said matter be submitted upon stipulation to the District Court of Tulsa County.

NOW THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners by and through Pat Malloy, County Attorney, its attorney, enter into a stipulation with N. J. Gubser submitting the matters mentioned in the forepart of this resolution to the District Court for its decision, both parties reserving the right of appeal from the decision of the said District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
