

December 21st, 1942.

The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Greer, who moved its adoption; said motion being seconded by Commissioner Morley. Chairman ordered the Resolution read.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of October, 1940, there was filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, a petition for the creation of a levy and drainage district beginning where the southeast corner of Newblock Park intersects the meander of the Arkansas River in Section 11, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, and following the said meander line up stream and westerly, etc., as per description set forth in detail in said petition, and

WHEREAS, the petition contained a prayer that the Board of County Commissioners proceed in the manner provided by law to cause said levy and drainage district to be created, and

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of October, 1940, said petition was presented to said Board and a resolution was duly passed in accordance with the prayer of the petitioners contained in said petition, and thus there was created a levy and drainage district affecting land and improvements in the area described and set out in said petition, and the district known as Tulsa County Drainage District No. 11, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners appointed viewers as provided by law who qualified and made their report in writing on the 14th day of January, 1941, and

WHEREAS, on the 24th day of March, 1941, the Board of County Commissioners, by written resolution, certified to the District Judge of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, the necessity and request for the appointment of three disinterested freeholders from the regular jury list to act as viewers of the Tulsa County Drainage District No. 11, as required by law, and

WHEREAS, on the 24th day of January, 1942, the Honorable Leslie Webb, District Judge of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in case No. 70497, entered an order appointing viewers for said Drainage District as provided by law, and

WHEREAS, it has now developed that Federal aid cannot be had for the construction and the work on said drainage District unless and until additional area and territory is taken in and included in the District, and

WHEREAS, there are no outstanding obligations or liabilities against said Drainage District, and the purposes for which said District were created cannot be fulfilled and carried out under the present conditions. The Board of County Commissioners being of the opinion that all proceedings for the creation of said Tulsa County Drainage District No. 11 should be vacated, set aside and held for naught, and new proceedings be commenced for the creation of a drainage district, and thereby include and incorporate therein additional area.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that all proceedings had before the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in connection with the Tulsa County Drainage District No. 11, be and the same is hereby vacated, set aside and held for naught.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, so that said Court can enter an order vacating its order appointing viewers for said Drainage District.
