The polls shall be opened at seven o'clock A. M. and remain open continuously until and be closed at six o'clock P. M. and the election shall be conducted in the manner prescribed by law for such elections.

Qualified electors for this election are: All persons, male or female, over the age of twenty one years, citizens of the United States, who have resided in the state one year, in the county six months and in the election precinct thirty days next preceding this election and who have been duly registered and who are not within the excepted classes enumerated in Section 1, Article 3 of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma.


