NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to purchase said Chevrolet Pickup, and that the County Highway Department be authorized to draw a claim to Haynes Auto Supply Company in the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00), payable from Account Number 8, designated as "Purchase of Tools, Trucks and Equipment" of the County Highway Department Account of the Cash Fund.
