

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 18, 1946

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M. with the following members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer, Member. Andy Stokes, County Clerk. Claude W. Bailey, Member, absent.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be and hereby is authorized to execute the election Expense claims for the Election held on November 5, 1946, in the amount of \$5,212.50. Upon roll call, both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that Earl R. Holmes be appointed Deputy in the Court Clerk's office, effective as of November 15, 1946, replacing Jay Bullard who resigned. Upon roll call, both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed and approved by Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, in favor of Walter L. Delaney, in the amount of \$70.05, covering lot 6, block 5, Acre Gardens for the years 1945 and 1946 inclusive, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is authorized to issue certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by Emile F. Sterger, Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas for the month of October, 1946, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the bid filed by Standard Paving Company covering the construction of the Shell Creek Bridge, in the amount of \$49,681.71, be referred to the County Engineer for compilation and report. Upon roll call, both members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that a recess be taken until Thursday, November 21st, 1946, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M. Motion carried.
