Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that Glen Condon be appointed to fill the unexpired term of William P. Stevens, who resigned, on the Tulsa State Fair Board. Upon roll call all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer to recess until the hour of 2:00 o'clock P.M., July 31st. Upon roll call all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
