Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the county Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$10,980.18, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Restricted Cash Fund of Tulsa County, in the amount of \$5,157.03, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is authorize to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
