

WHEREAS, under the law and contract for issuance and sale of said Bonds and the purchase thereof, the said lands within the incorporation of the Town of Dawson and certain other tracts now attached to the City of Tulsa, were included as property valuation bonds and obligated to be included and part of the valuations in the Sinking Fund created by said Board of County Commissioners; said retiring of said bonds as they matured and the paying of maturing interest coupons.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the County Assessor of Tulsa County be and he is hereby directed to include for Sinking Funds purposes against said Bond issue, for the tax year of 1923, and subsequent years during the life of said Bonds the taxable property of the corporate Town of Dawson, and the certain other tracts now attached to the City of Tulsa.
