MONDAY, NOVEMBER 21st, 1938.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, November 21st, 1938, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that \$150.00 be allocated to the Welfare department, said amount to be used for Shoes and Clothing for Tulsa High School students, said amount to be paid at the rate of \$50.00 per month, and charged to Account Q-3-P. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the Chairman be authorized to issue a Quit Claim Deed to John M. McNamee on Lot 11, Block 4, Peoria Acres Sub-Division of Lots 7,8,9 and 12 to 16 of Peoria Acres Addition to City of Tulsa, for the reason that said lot was sold in error by the County; said taxes having been paid prior to the date of re-sale. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the Chairman be authorized to issue a Quit Claim deed to Nelson Henry on Lot 17, Block 2, Sunny Brook Addition to Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the reason that said lot was sold in error by the County; said taxes having been paid prior to the date of re-sale. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the hearing on the affidavits of erroneous assessment filed by R. S. Laird, Agent for Pearl M. Alexander and Mary C. Alexander, be and the same is hereby continued until Monday, December 5th, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
