The Standard Paving Company was only bidder on this project. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey seconded by Commissioner Gray that John Boyd, Director of the Tulsa County Welfare, be and hereby is instructed to sell the cars used by the Case workers in the Welfare Department at a price of \$200.00 each, giving the case workers priority in the purchase of the cars. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
