RESOLUTION.

On this the 3rd day of April, 1917, it appearing that there has been confiscated to the State of Oklahoma, inproceedings pending in the County Court of Tulsa County, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, wherein the Randal Motor Car Company was Intervenor, one Velie Roadster # 51656, Enginer No. 70W10741:

And , it also appearing that there has been confiscated to the State of Oklahoma, in an action in the County Court wherein C. R. Adams was intervenor, one Chalmers Automobile # 44478:

And, it also appearing that there has been confiscated to the State of Oklahoma, in an action in the County Court wherein one M. Brown was intervenor, one Dodge automobile #25832:

That the same was ordered to be turned over to the County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to be disposed of according to law.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, That the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, give due and legal notice and sell said automobiles to the highest bidder and make his report to this Honorable Body, showing what disposition he has made of said aytomobiles.

It is hereby ordered, considered and adjudged that the Clerk also advertise and sell according to law any other property which has been libeled and confiscated, and turned over to this Board by order of the County Judge, and make due return thereof showing what he has done in the premises, according to law.

The petition of the Sinclair Oil & Gas Company, asking that they be permisted to lay, maintain and operate lines of pipe for the conveyance of oil and gas, along and across any of the public highways in Tulsa County, was approved by the Board of County Commissioners, April 5, 1917.

The petition of A.W. Sheppard for laying one inch gas pipe line across the Ozark Trail at intersection of St. L & S. F.R.R. one mile south of Dawson, Okla, was approved by the Board of Commissioners, April 5, 1917.

The petition of the Producers Oil Company.

The petition of the Producers Oil Company, by R.I. Short, was filed with the Board of County Commissioners, whereby they ask permission to maintain and operate a two inch gas pipe line along the public road between Sections 19, 20, 29, 30, 31 and 32, Tqp 20 N. Range 13 East, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma. Said petition was granted.

The petition of the Yarhola Pipe Line Company, pryaing for authority to use certain highways and public places of Tulsa County for the purpose of laying pipe lines and erecting a line or lines of poles with telephone and telegraph wires thereon, was granted by the Board.
