Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the applications for re-assessment of unpaid ad valorem tax approved on September 22nd, 1937, be and the same are hereby ordered cancelled. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
