WHEREAS, the County Treasurer has presented to this Board the foregoing  
transcript in said sale, with all papers and proofs relating to said sale, for the approval  
of this Board of County Commissioners, and

This Board of County Commissioners being convened in the office of the County  
Clerk of said County and State on the date hereinafter set forth.

WE HAVE CAREFULLY EXAMINED said transcript and proceedings, and find:

1. That the sale of Lots 1-2-3-10-14 and 15, Block 1, French Addition to  
Collinsville, Oklahoma, to W. M. Bryan for a consideration of \$6.00 was properly advertised and  
fairly conducted and the amount of the sale is deemed a fair price.

THEREFORE, so finding, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State
