TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
TULSA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA:

The undersigned hereby request permission and authorization from your Board to construct certain water lines in public roads or highways outside of corporate cities or towns in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as shown in the plat which is hereto attached and made a part of this application; the location of the proposed water lines being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

315 L.F. of 6" C.I. Pipe on Evanston Avenue from the S.L. of 27th Place to a point 315 feet South.

1000 L.F. of 2" Water Line on Delaware Place from 28th Street to 27th Place, thence East on 27th Place to Evanston Avenue, to serve Craig Heights.

It is understood and agreed that said permission and authorization, if granted, shall be subject to the following provisions which are hereby agreed to by applicant:

1. Permanent markers shall be placed by the applicant showing the location of said water lines.
2. The applicant agrees to maintain and keep in good repair the said water lines until such time as the land on which they are located is annexed to the City of Tulsa.
