MONDAY, JANUARY 4th, 1943.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, January 4th, 1943, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that Mrs. Sarah E. Freeman be and she is hereby appointed Justice of the Peace in District No. 12, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, subject to the approval of her bond, to fill the vacancy created by the death of her husband, Floyd V. Freeman. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the bond filed by Floyd V. Freeman, elected Justice of the Peace in and for District No. 12, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in the amount of \$1,000 and made by the United States Fidelity & Guaranty Company, be and the same is hereby cancelled. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Mr. Morley: On December 7th, 1942, Fred Hart was appointed Justice of the Peace in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, District No. 6, but never furnished bond, therefore, a vacancy exist. Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that M. P. Howser be appointed Justice of the Peace in and for District No. 6, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of W. C. Showman, elected Justice of the Peace, and that the resignation of W. C. Showman, be and the same is hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the resignation of Dave Sikes, elected Constable for District No. 4, Division No. 4, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby accepted. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
