In the matter of the application of the TULSA FUEL & MFG CO. for permission to lay gas pipe line under the paved highway the following order was made:

O R D E R

Upon the application of The Tulsa Fuel & Mfg. Company, a corporation, for permission to lay a three inch gas pipe line for the transportation of natural gas under the paved road running from Tulsa to Collinsville, at a point just south of the bridge where said road crosses Bird Creek, between Section 1, Township 20 North, Range 13 East and Section 6, Township 20 North, Range 14 East, at the half mile line, the said application having been considered and having been duly approved by the County Engineer.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, That the Tulsa Fuel & Mfg. Company, a corporation be and it is hereby granted permission to lay and maintain under the paved road above referred to and at the point above specified, a three inch gas pipe line for the transportation of natural gas, such line to be laid, maintained and removed in such manner and with such due care that the road or pavement will be in no wise damaged thereby and under the supervision of and in accordance with the specifications of the County Engineer the said The Tulsa Fuel & Mfg. Co. to hold the County of Tulsa safe and harmless from all damaged or injuries which may be sustained by the County, or by any person, by reason of the laying, maintaining or removal of said line.

At a regularly adjourned meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, held on the 23rd. day of October, 1925, the following Resolution was introduced by W L North and the motion to adopt the resolution was seconded by J S Shaver and ordered read:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, certain lands are needed for highway purposes, and

WHEREAS, it has been impossible to obtain same on amicable terms.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That upon the recommendation of the County Engineer, the County Attorney is hereby requested to bring condemnation proceedings against the owner, MAGGIE McWORTER, on the following described property, to-wit:

That part of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty Two (32) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, described as beginning at the Northeast corner of said tract of land and running thence West Thirty Three (33') feet; thence South Four Hundred and Five (405') Feet; thence West Twenty Two (22') feet; thence South One Hundred and Twenty-five (125') feet; thence East Twenty Two (22') feet; thence South One Hundred and Fifty (150') feet; thence West Twenty Two (22') feet; thence South Two Hundred (200') feet; thence East Twenty Two (22') feet thence South Four Hundred and Forty (440') feet to the South line of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence East Thirty Three (33') feet; thence North One Thousand Three Hundred and twenty (1320') feet to place of beginning and containing, less previously owned by Tulsa County, 6.41 acres
