

America by G. A. Porter, Marshall of the eastern District of Oklahoma, acting under the authority of the Attorney General and for and in behalf of the United States, party of the first part, and W. L. North, C. H. Cleveland & George McFecham county Commissioners of Tulsa Co. State of Oklahoma, party of the second part; Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein after mentioned does hereby agree with the said party of the second part, to feed and guard such prisoners or prisoners as may be lawfully committed by the proper authorities of Tulsa County to the United States Jail at Vinita, Oklahoma, upon the following conditions to wit: That the party of the second part shall reimburse the party of the first part for all amounts expended for the support and custody of such prisoners, said amount to be determined by the United States Marshal, on the basis of the per capita per diem cost of the support and custody of such prisoners, both state and federal confined in said jail by which this contract may be terminated at any time by the party of the first part and that it may be terminated by the party of second part after thirty days notice in writing to the party of the first part. That this contract is not binding upon party of first part until approved by the Attorney General of the United States. That all prisoners committed under this agreement shall be subject to the rules and regulations in force in said jail during their confinement therein. That the party of the second part shall reimburse the party of the first part for all amounts expended for medical attendance, medicine and necessary clothing for prisoners confined under this agreement. In witness whereof the said party is to wit, the party of the first, by G. A. Porter, U. S. Marshall, and the party of the second party by W. L. North, C. H. Cleveland & Geo. McFecham in the capacity aforesaid, have hereunto set their hands and their seals the day and year first above written
