ELECTION PROCLAMATION

PROCLAMATION IS HEREBY GIVEN that under and by virtue of Section 26, Article 10 of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma, and Title 70, Sections 907.1 to 907.7 both inclusive, O. S. 1941 and laws supplementary and amendatory thereto, and a resolution duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, on the 13th day of July, 1948, an election will be held in said county on the 27th day of July, 1948 for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said county the following proposition:

"Shall the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, by it's Board of County Commissioners, incur an indebtedness by issuing it's negotiable coupon bonds in the sum of Nine Hundred Ninety Seven Thousand, Five Hundred (\$997,500.00) Dollars, for the purpose of providing additional funds for the purpose of purchasing school sites, erecting school buildings, purchasing school furniture and fixtures, making school building repairs and making school site improvements, all for the permanent improvement of the separate schools of said Tulsa County, to be owned exclusively by said county, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said county, sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it falls due and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof at maturity, said bonds to bear interest at not to exceed four (4) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually and to become due serially within twenty years from their date, the total estimated cost of which separate school permanent improvements is One Million, Nine Hundred Fifteen Thousand, Nine Hundred and Thirty (\$1,915,930.00) Dollars."

The ballots used at said election shall be individually printed and shall set out the proposition substantially as above set forth and shall also contain the words:

FIRST:	FOR THE BONDS
SECOND:	AGAINST THE BONDS

(An elector desiring to vote for the bond issue shall stamp or mark an "X" in this first square above and if he desires to vote against the bond issue he shall stamp or make an "X" in the second square above)

Said election shall be held at the regular voting places in said county established by the County Election Board and shall be conducted by the County Election Board and the regular precinct officials appointed by the County Election Board for the conduct of other county-wide elections, such places and officials being as follows:
