MONDAY, OCTOBER 21st, 1935.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, October 21st, 1935, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the report of E. A. Watterfield for the month of September, 1935, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the following lease to Joe Dempsey be approved. Chairman ordered the lease read.

L E A S E

This lease made this 21st day of October, 1935, by and between the Board of County Commissioners, party of the first part, and Joe Dempsey, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That said party of the first part in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth does by these presents demise, lease and let unto the second party the ground located in the center of the county highway at the Southwest Corner of Sec. 7, Twp. 17, Range 13, Glen Pool Township, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, now known as Hilltop Service Station, for the purpose of running a filling Station.

To have and to hold the same to the second part from the 21st day of October, 1935, to the 21st day of October, 1936. And said second party, in consideration of the premises herein set forth, agrees to pay to the first party, as rental for the above described ground the sum of \$35.00 per year, in advance.
