WHEREAS, the law provides that the County Commissioners may contract with any person or persons to assist the proper officers of the County in discovery, listing and assessing of property not assessed as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in meeting assembled, that a contract be and is hereby made and entered into with BERT C HODGES of Okmulgee, Oklahoma, to assist the proper o ficers of this County, in listing and assessing omitted property, after discovery by him, in accordance with the provisions of the Sections 9798 to 9801 and other Oklahoma Statutes covering the duties of a Tax Ferret but that insofar as this particular contract is concerned it is limited to the following classes of property.

> Estates that are nor or have been under the control of Guardians, Administrators and Executors.

Oil Field Equipment, and Supply Houses.
