

MINUTES
THURSDAY, APRIL 24, 1986

The Board of County Commissioners for Tulsa County, Oklahoma met at the hour of 9:00 a.m., with the following members present: John Selph, Chairman; Lewis Harris, Member. Members absent: Melvin C. Rice. Others present: Clayton Edwards, Susan Morgan, Mack Bettis, Jack Gordon, Wayne Carr, Herb Reed, Melody Bishop, and Mike Kimbrell.

John Selph, Chairman, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m., and the following business was transacted:

Mack Bettis and Jack Gordon were present to discuss the CAMA System update. Gordon stated that the CAMA System for all practical purposes is complete. Bettis stated the Assessor's office is ready to hire two additional appraisers, but they do not have the money in their FY85-86 budget. Harris suggested the reserve be released for the Assessor's office. Selph stated he would like to review the funds with Carr before releasing the reserve.
