Motion by Commissioner Gray, that the Bond filed by C. A. Bingham as Treasurer, Tulsa County Hospital, in the amount of \$1,000 and made by the Maryland Casualty Company, be and the same is hereby cancelled as of July 23rd, 1941. Motion seconded by Commissioner Morley, and upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, that the Memorandum of Understanding between Oklahoma State Board of Public Welfare and Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby approved as of July 23rd, 1941. Motion seconded by Commissioner Morley, and upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried. (Same filed under No. 43228).

Motion by Commissioner Morley, that the Building Superintendent be authorized to accept the lowest bid running conduit wiring from jail to basement switch-board Jail circuit separate from rest of courthouse and removing second and third floor curcuit from present jail circuit - turnkey job for labor and material, same being declared emergency. The lowest bidder being the Circle "L" Electric Company in amount of \$107.36. Motion seconded by Commissioner Greer, and upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried,

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by C. H. Benton covering realestate for the City of Sand Springs, for the years 1931, 1932 and 1934, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue a certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
