Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

The minutes of July 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 14th, 15th, 16th and 17th were read and there being no objection to the same, motion was made by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that they stand approved as read. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, that George Bell's salary be increased to \$225.00 plus \$35.00 per month expenses. Motion seconded by Commissioner Gray, and upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that a recess be taken until Saturday, July 26th, 1941, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. Motion carried.
