

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, held in the office of said Commissioners in the Court House in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, on the 4th. day of June, A.D. 1923, the following resolution was introduced by F.M. Wooden, a member of said Board and who moved its adoption, and the motion was seconded by Geo.E. Gilmore, a member of said Board, and the Chairman ordered the Resolution read:

### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Contract existing between this Board and W.M. Gulager, Tax Ferret, expires June 30th. 1923, and

WHEREAS, there are now, and will be on the date of the expiration of said Contract various suits pending in the Courts involving omitted property placed on the rolls of said County by the County Treasurer of said County, upon the application of said W.M. Gulager as Tax Ferret, and

WHEREAS, in order for the County Treasurer to properly prepare and present the facts in the trial of said cases it is necessary for him to have the assistance of said W.M. Gulager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the said W.M. Gulager be and he is hereby authorized, empowered and instructed to co-operate with the County Attorney and County Treasurer of this County in said cases until same are finally disposed of.

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The motion to adopt resolution having received a majority of the votes of said Commissioners, the Resolution was declared carried and ordered made of record.

Motion was made by Ira Short, seconded by F.M. Wooden, that the Deed of Dedication, which is given in detail below, be and the same is hereby accepted. Motion carried.

### DEED OF DEDICATION.

WHEREAS, J.A. Porter and C.H. Sweet, the owners of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Section Nine (9) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East have laid off and set aside for road and street purposes the South Forty (S40') of the said Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 9, as aforesaid, and have agreed to reserve the South Ten feet (S10') of said South Forty Feet (S40') as aforesaid, for park purposes.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, J.E. Crosbie and Elizabeth Crosbie, his wife, the owners of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter of Section Nine (9) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, beginning forty (40) acres immediately adjoining the land first hereinbefore described, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid by the said J.A. Porter and C.H. Sweet and for the further consideration as hereinbefore referred to, of the dedication by the said J.A. Porter and C.H. Sweet of the said forty feet (40') along the south side of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Nine (9) as aforesaid and the South Ten feet (S10') of said South forty feet (S40') being reserved for park purposes, have caused to be surveyed and set off for road and street purposes the North forty feet (N40') feet of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Nine (9), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East. Provided, however, that the North Ten feet (N10') of said Forty Feet (40') as aforesaid, shall be used in connection with the ten feet (10') reserved by the said J.A. Porter and C.H. Sweet for park purposes, and, providing further that an easement be, and the same is hereby granted the OKLAHOMA NATURAL GAS COMPANY to a tract of ground fifteen feet (15' X 20') by twenty feet, described as follows:

Beginning at a point thirty feet south (30'S) of the Southwest corner of Lot Ten (10) in Block Six (6) of Sunrise Terrace Addition; thence running south twenty feet (20'); thence East fifteen feet (15') parallel with the south line of said Lot Ten (10) in Block Six (6); thence North Twenty (20') feet; thence West fifteen feet (15') to the point of beginning.

Said easement being for the purpose of a site for a gas regulator to serve the said Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Nine (9) as well as the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Nine (9) all in Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East.

And we do hereby dedicate all of said street as aforesaid to the use of the public, forever.
