State of Oklahoma, and approved and in force and effect from and after the passage and approval, and approved on April 13, 1929, authorizing and empowering the Board of County Commissioners in each County in the State of Oklahoma to call an election for the purpose of issuing bonds to purchase lands, improve the same, and to construct huildings thereon for free fair purposes, the same to be owned and controlled by such counties, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, in regular session assembled with all members present does hereby call and proclaim a special election to be held in and throughout the said Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, and in each voting precinct in said County on Tuesday the 4th. day of November, 1930, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said County the following proposition:

PROPOSITION.

S hall the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, acting for and on behalf and in the name of said County be authorized and empowered to incur an indebtedness by issung negotiable coupon bonds in the aggregate principal of Five Hundred Thousand (\$500,000.00)Dollars for the purpose of provinding funds to purchase lands, improve the same and to construct buildings thereon for free fair purposes, the same to be owned and controlled by said Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, said bonds to bear interest at a rate not to exceed six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, and such bonds shall be issued in denominations of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or any multiple thereof, not to exceed One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars and the entire amount of said bond issue shall be payable within twenty-five years from the date thereof, and shall be made to mature in annual installments beginning in not less than three (3) years, nor more than five (5) years after their date, and said bonds to be known as "Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Free Fair Bonds of 1930", and authorizing and empowering the officers of said Tulsa County, charged by law with levying taxes for County purposes to levy annually an amount sufficient to pay the interest due each year on the bonds issued, and in addition thereot, levy an amount sufficient to pay the principal of said bonds as the same falls due, said levies to be in addition to all other taxes levied in said County for County purposes.

FORM OF BALLOT.

The ballots used in special election shall set out the proposition and question for submission to the qualified voters of said County as above set forth and shall also contain the following words:

FOR THE PROPOSITION

AGAINST THE PROPOSITION.

A voter desiring to vote for the proposition shall stamp an X in the square before and preceding thewords "For the proposition". A voter desiring to vote against the proposition shall stamp an X in the square before and preceding the words "Against the proposition.

The polls shall be opened in the forenoon at the hour of eight o'clock and shall be kept open, continuously, until the hour of six o'clock in the afternoon, on said 4th. day of:November, 1930, provided that in cities of the first class in said County, the polls shall be opened at six o'clock in the forenoon, and shall be kept continuously open until the hour of seven o'clock in the afternoon on said 4th. day of November, 1930.
