Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners, reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M., August 14th, with all members present: Curtis Greer, Chairman, J. B. Gray and Robert L. Kinkaid, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Curtis Greer, Chairman, presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Board set the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M., August 17th, to discuss the appointment of a new Fair Board, and to permit the public interested in the Fair to come before the Board and express their views in regard to the appropriation of money to carry out the County Fair. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken. Commissioner Greer, "AYE", Commissioner Kinkaid, "AYE", Commissioner Gray, "NO". Motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded By Commissioner Gray that the report filed by Emile Sterger, Clerk of Common Pleas Court, for the month of July, 1944, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the report filed by A. Garland Marrs, Sheriff of Tulsa County, for boarding of County Prisoners for the month of July, 1944, be and the same is hereby approved and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the appointment of Alma C. Hyden as Assistant Probation Officer at a salary of \$125.00 per month, effective as of July 25, 1944, requested by James P. Melone, County Judge, be approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
