

On account of the shortage of funds for the construction work in Owasso Township, a motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that W. G. Ogan make his report and file his resignation, and that C. E. Stewart who is now doing the dragging work in said township be appointed as township road supervisor for the East Onehalf (E½) of Owasso Township to do such work as shall be deemed necessary until another appropriation is made and approved, and it is further ordered that the county clerk notify W. G. Ogan of the action of this Board, and instruct the said W. G. Ogan to turn over to the said C. E. Stewart all tools and road equipment he may have belonging to Owasso Township and to the County of Tulsa.

The said motion being by the Chairman put to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows: For the Motion, W. L. North, F. M. Wooden and Ed Dalton, Against the motion none. The Chairman then declared the motion carried.

A motion was made by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the recommendation of the County Engineer on the road between West Tulsa and the Creek County Line be approved, and that Dan W. Patton, County Engineer be authorized to advertise for bids for one mile of the same with the privilege of extending the contract. Motion prevailed.

It is moved by W. L. North and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the following contract between the Hughes Engineering Company and the Board of County Commissioners acting for and on behalf of the drainage district described in said contract be approved, and that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be and he is hereby authorized to execute said Contract in the name of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
