NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in consideration of the early issuance by the State Highway Commission of work order on the 51st Street Project, Federal Project No. U591 (2), and upon validation of the said \$900,000.00 issue of County Road Bonds, so above referred to, and the consummation of the sale and delivery thereof, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, will undertake to, and will, prior to completion of the 51st Street Project, acquire by contracts with owners, or through condemnation proceedings:

- (1) Minimum right-of-way 175 feet along the Circumferential Route above described and referred to, lying outside the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa, together with additional right-of-way necessary for construction in accordance with the plans to be approved by Bureau of Public Roads.
- (2) Additional right-of-way at intersections as needed, in accordance with plans to be approved by Bureau of Public Roads,

insofar as this Board is legally empowered to do, and insofar as conditions over which this Board has any control, may permit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in case the Bureau of Public Roads should approve any variation or relocation of said route at the request of the City or County of Tulsa, then this resolution shall cover such variation or relocation in lieu of the described route.

PASSED AND APPROVED this 22nd day of July, 1950, in adjourned regular session assembled.
