WHEREAS, Tulsa County owns Three Caterpillar Tractors described as follows:

WHEREAS, the Highway Department owns a Caterpillar "35" Tractor, Motor Number 5C1568 that is in need of repair and has found that a trade or exchange can be made with the Southwest Machinery Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma, whereby the Southwest Machinery Company will allow a credit of \$300.00 on labor and materials necessary to repair said Caterpillar "35" Tractor, Motor Number 5C1568 in exchange for the above named Caterpillar Tractors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to make said trade with the Southwest Machinery Company.
