R E S O L U T I O N

The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Hedgecock, who moved its adoption, and said motion being seconded by Commissioner Dickey, and the the Chairman ordered the Resolution read:

WHEREAS, for the purpose of constructing a highway through and across certain land in Section Two (2), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, it is necessary to acquire a strip of land particularly described as follows:

"A strip of land for public highway purposes, said strip being the North Forty (40') feet of Lots Five (5) and Six (6), Section Two (2), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, containing 2.4 acres, more or less"

AND, WHEREAS, Tulsa County has been unable to affect an amicable settlement in the matter of said strip of land owned by L S ROBSON, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to acquire said strip of land for right of way for highway purposes by condemnation proceedings,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the County Attorney, in the name of the Board for and on behalf thereof, be and he is hereby instructed to institute condemnation proceedings in the District Court of this County for the purpose of condemning said above described tract of land for highway purposes.

All voting in the affirmative, the motion was declared carried.
