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MONDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 1933.

The Board of County Commissioners met in adjourned regular session with all Members present: Ed W Hedgecock, Chairman, W L North and Wm.O.Bohnefeld, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with, and there being no objections to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Chairman Hedgecock presiding, the following business was transacted:

Motion was made by Mr.North, seconded by Mr.Hedgecock, that an allowance of \$6.00 per month be and the same is hereby granted to Mrs.Alfred Cripe. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Mr.North, seconded by Mr.Hedgecock, that in the matter of the claims of Leonard Cook and George Blower, that the County Attorney be requested to advise the Board of County Commissioners as to the method of procedure in handling of said claims. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Mr.North, seconded by Mr.Bohnefeld, that the Board of County Commissioners dedicate to the public a strip of land twenty-five (25') feet wide for right of way for highway purposes, being the East twenty-five (25') feet of the North half (N $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Eighteen (18), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, containing 0.74 acres, more or less. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Mr.North, seconded by Mr.Bohnefeld, that the State Examiner and Inspector be requested to have Jubel Wilson, Deputy State Examiner and Inspector to return to Tulsa County and check the appropriations to see whether or not we are out of line before protests come up before the Board of Tax Review in Oklahoma City on March 20th 1933. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Mr.North, seconded by Mr.Bohnefeld, that the Western Union Telegraph Company be notified to remove their clocks from the Court House on or before April 1st. 1933 and that we accept the proposition of the Postal Telegraph Sales Corporation on the installation of their clocks. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Mr.North, seconded by Mr.Bohnefeld, that the Frates Company be requested to return Warrant No. 5400 back to the County Clerk as duplicate warrant is out for the same purpose. Motion carried.

In the matter of the Petition of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line under, through and across certain highways in said County and State, the following Order was made:
